



THE CHAMBER CELEBRATES 60 YEARS OF KEEPING OUR COMMUNITY INFORMED!



This month marks the 60th anniversary of the founding of the original format of this publication. The inaugural issue of the Chamber's publication was printed in January 1956, the month before Executive Director, Jesse Walters, was born.

Shown here is the oldest known existing copy of what was then known simply as our *Newsletter*, from April 1963, as well as the edition from November 1989 celebrating Barry University's 50th. anniversary. Re-christened *News and Views* shortly thereafter, it was re-branded as the *Egret* magazine in November 2011, and the first cover of the new, full color format is shown here, announcing Lance Harke as "Citizen of the Year".

Thanks to all of our hundreds of advertisers over the years. Without their support we would not be able to print 7,000 copies a month and distribute them in Miami Shores, Biscayne Park, and El Portal!




